Read Acts 1:8; Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 2:1-13;

- 1. Why is 'The Acts of Jesus and the Holy Spirit' a more apt title for the book of Acts than 'The Acts of the Apostles'?
- 2. In what way do you and I feature in Acts 29? a. Does this excite you in any way?
- 3. What can we learn from Acts 2:1?
- 4. Describe what happened in the house they were in?
- 5. Why did God give them different languages to praise Him?
- 6. What was the response of the crowd that gathered? How do different people today respond to your testimony of Jesus?
- 7. What do you think is the main application of this passage for us today?
- 8. Were there any other things on the morning where God spoke to you?
- 9. The Spirit came suddenly. The Spirit does things His way and in His timing. Sometimes loud and visible and sometimes He is the still small voice. How do we learn to walk in the Spirit? Discuss.
- 10. Stuart said we need to make sure we are not paralysed in our Christian walk only waiting for the loud and extravagant moves of the Spirit (which we do long for more of) and miss out on the miraculous in the mundane. What does the Spirit empowered day to day look like for you?
- 11. Stuart finished by saying that 'Holy Spirit empowered love' is like a foreign language that will amaze and perplex people. How do we practically walk in this today?
